Financial Information

The student is required to pay the application fee when the application is submitted and on or before the final due date for applications. Along with tuition and materials fees, each student must pay the system fee during the length of the program and a \$100 graduation fee prior to the end of the program. The Application fee is non-refundable. Tuition, System, Graduation, and Material fees are refundable per the Refund Policy and Procedure. As part of some homework assignments, students are required to submit and pay for the proper documentation to legally start their business. The specific amount of fees necessary will vary based on the location of the business that is started
